TONNAGE REPORTS ARE NOW DUE

Attention: Commercial Business and Institutional Property Owners

Your 2024 recycling tonnage reports are now due and must be submitted to the Township of Fairfield recycling coordinator on or before **March 1, 2025**.

Every business, institution, or industrial facility shall report on an annual basis to the Recycling Coordinator on recycling activities at their premises, including the amount of recycled material, by material type, collected and recycled and the vendor or vendors providing recycling service. All food service establishments, as defined in the Health Code, shall, in addition to compliance with all other recycling requirements, be required to recycle grease and/or cooking oil created in the processing of food or food product.
