**BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARIES**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township of Fairfield, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey on July 28, 2025 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

**Title:** Bond Ordinance Providing An Appropriation Of \$1,000,000 For Various Capital Improvements and Purpose For And By The Township Of Fairfield, In The County Of Essex, New Jersey And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$950,000 Bonds Or Notes Of The Township For Financing Part Of The Appropriation.

**Purpose(s):** Resurfacing of various Township Roads for the Engineering Department, including but not limited to Edgewood Terrace, Mayfair Drive, Jocine Drive, Bates Drive, Deer Park Road, Angeline Court, John Street and Hollywood Mini Park; Acquisition of emergency sport utility vehicles, Technology upgrades, including but not limited to desktop computers and monitors/televisions for the Police Department; Various improvements to the Municipal Complex, including but not limited to renovations and structures; and Various acquisitions for the Fire Department, including but not limited to, hoses, nozzles, pagers, turnout gear, radios, water rescue gear, ladders, knox box, ram air fans.
